- 7. Evaluates assistant coaches and playing personnel and aids participants in securing scholarship assistance.
- 8. Maintains and inventories all equipment and supplies.
- 9. Plans and develops game responsibilities.
- 10. Assists in the overall district football program including little league, junior high, sophomore, and varsity.

- 11. Assists the athletic director in scheduling, development of budget, administration of the football budget, and making travel arrangements.
- 12. Maintains professional growth through attendance of coaching clinics, conferences, and post graduate study.
- 13. Performs other tasks and assumes other responsibilities as the athletic director, principal, Superintendent and/or board may assign.
